Dr. Manaig was born and raised by a modest family with 7 siblings in the birthplace of our national hero Dr. Jose Rizal , in Calamba, Laguna Philippines on May 28, 1946. He spent his elementary years in the local public school and graduated high school in Laguna Institute in 1966. He took his Bachelor's Degree in Science in Far Eastern University, Manila Philippines, and finished his

Medical Degree in the same university in 1972. In his early medical student days, he already led and joined medical missions sponsored by the university wherein he saw the horrible health conditions of the Filipino people.

After one year of Private Practice in the Philippines, he immigrated with his wife, the former Estela Penetrante, a former Librarian with the US Dept. of Defense Schools, Clark Air Force Base Philippines, to the United States in June of 1974. He moved his family then to Buffalo, New York, where he had his 1st year Residency Training in Anesthesiology at Millard Fillmore Hospital in 1978-1979. The following year, he took his Residency Training in Internal Medicine at Mercy Hospital And Medical Center, Buffalo New York. The Internal Medicine Residency Program was completed at the University of Alabama School of Medicine, Montgomery Internal Medicine Residency Program, from 1980-1982.

He came back to his beloved San Diego in 1982 and started his private practice until now in Paradise Hills.
